IAPE | MEXICO

IAPE (Inter-American Partnership for Education) is a partnership between Dartmouth College's Rassias Center and Educando that trains, supports, and empowers English teachers. It utilizes the Rassias Method®, that encourages communication by breaking down fear and inhibition.

LISTO | MEXICO

LISTO trains and supports principals in instructional, transformational, and organizational leadership. Through a combination of workshops and coaching, its goal is to foster leaders who create effective learning environments that involve teachers, parents, and the community in improving learning outcomes.

STEM | BRASIL STEM | MEXICO

STEM Brasil and STEM México offer top-quality training and support to Science and Math teachers in middle and high schools. STEM is a hands-on, comprehensive teacher training program that synthesizes the official Brazilian and Mexican curricula with innovation, technology, creativity, practical projects and local context.

LISTO | MÉXICO

LISTO trains and supports principals serving in Mexican public schools. It is a two-year (257 hours) intensive course of study for 50 principals at a time, that combines theory, hands-on practice, and individualized monitoring.

For every participant, LISTO creates a “leadership diagnosis” and measures the transformation of each principal’s leadership style throughout the program, evaluating the prevailing culture at each school in order to create a personalized intervention plan.

LISTO principals attend in-person workshops that provide training in strategic planning, best practices in school management, and transformative leadership. The principals also receive individualized coaching in-person and through an online platform, as they bridge theory and practice, evaluate their progress, and implement strategic plans. Through the platform they can communicate with other LISTO principals and share best practices.
